

MacMahan Playhouse Rules

The Playhouse is open for use by all Islanders. Please follow these rules so that everyone may enjoy the building. It belongs to all of us!

1. Please keep the Playhouse clean. It is not for the use of raccoons and ants.
2. When leaving, please make sure all doors are shut and all lights are off.
3. Please put away anything that you took out or used. It is nice to clean up after someone else if they happened to forget! Remember to allow enough time to clean up, if you have to be home at a certain time.
4. The tuned piano (near the stage) is for serious pianists and is kept locked. The old piano may be used to play "Heart and Soul", etc.
5. Remember that people come to MacMahan for quiet vacations and that the sound travels easily over water and in the evenings. Many cottages hear all that goes on at the playhouse! Please keep the noise level and the stereo volume down.
6. In the evenings it is suggested that any children younger than Middle School age be supervised by a parent or babysitter. The older children are to be responsible for their own behavior. As long as there are no complaints, the door will remain unlocked. If the need to lock the door arises, one person will be allowed to sign out the key and accept responsibility for the Playhouse on that occasion.
7. If there are complaints or concerns, it is suggested that all parents and children involved meet to come to a consensus on solutions and rules. Do not let a problem fester and become worse, please resolve it immediately.
8. The Playhouse payphone number is 371-9940 should you need it. If the phone rings while you are in the Playhouse, please answer it. It could be an important call.
9. There will be no climbing on or hanging from the rafters. This behavior will cause an immediate locked door policy. We do not want anyone to get hurt. Please don't sit on the ping-pong table - it is fragile!
10. The Playhouse may be reserved by any cottager for a particular event by arrangement with the person on the Recreation Committee in charge. At such time a sign may be put on the door stating that the Playhouse is closed for... After such an event as a wedding reception, it is customary that the users make a donation to the Recreation Committee.
11. If you have a suggestion for the Playhouse or a request for a game please tell the Recreation Committee. Used games in good condition are welcome donations at any time. Games are kept in the benches.
