

## **MacMahan Tennis**

- ❑ The care of the tennis courts is the responsibility of all of the users.
- ❑ Setup is usually done on the Sunday morning of Memorial Day and takedown on the Sunday morning of Columbus Day weekend.
- ❑ Other projects are done on workdays scheduled during the Summer. Watch for notices on the floats and the Lodge bulletin board for times.
- ❑ Donations of time and money are always welcome - checks may be made out to the Recreation Committee.
- ❑ The Recreation Committee purchases supplies needed for court maintenance and repairs.
- ❑ Labor is done by volunteers.
- ❑ A portion of the profits from the store in the Lodge also benefits the courts.

## **Tennis Court Rules**

1. Please wear flat soled shoes. Basketball sneakers, running shoes and other footwear will dig up the court surface.
2. After playing brush the courts lengthwise with the wide broom (so that the dirt and sand doesn't go under the tapes) and sweep the tapes with the roller brush or a broom. Brooms and brushes should be hung on the tree after use to keep the bristles from bending. Thank you.
3. Most of the time the court will need watering after use. The court surface of pulverized clay and brick dust will blow away if not dampened.
4. Please recoil the hose and turn the water off at the valve after use, so that a hose leak or break won't wreck the court and waste the island's precious water.
5. Please do not raise or lower the net. Salt air and metal poles make this a difficult operation.
6. If people are waiting to play, please do not begin another set.
7. When entering or leaving the courts, please do not cross the other court if a game is in progress, walk around the outside of the fence.
8. Adult Round Robin Mixed Doubles daily at 9 am (9:30 Sundays) have court priority in the morning and youth in the afternoon.
