Dear Cottagers, Shareholders, and Renters:

An early priority of the Safety & Emergency Procedures Committee was to improve on delivery of time sensitive information to islanders. We analyzed our current system and identified our phone chain, the siren at the lodge, hand-held horns and runners between houses. Our goal was to come up with something better. We searched for a system that would alert islanders quickly, reach subscribers regardless of location, one that was not too expensive, too complicated, or too labor intensive. After investigating numerous alternatives, the AMG Alert System was identified and presented to the Board at the recommendation of the committee. Representative members participated in an impressive online demonstration and the Board then endorsed the Safety Committee's decision to adopt the AMG system. The new alert system was presented to the island at the May informational meeting and it was explained at that time that the old phone chain will cease and become part of the new system. Cottage owners should list their island land line among their contact preferences and the system will automatically call that number during an alert. Since the May meeting, we have conducted multiple controlled tests to verify the AMG technology. All tests have performed flawlessly and we are now ready to present AMG to the entire MacMahan community for broad implementation of the system.
